Village Level Workers (VLW) Training: Village level workers have been appointed by Govt. of Jharkhand for better understanding of agricultural knowledge. Government of Jharkhand has decided to impart 90 days residential training to each new recruited VLW. In this regard GVT-KVK, Godda has been selected to impart



training to 42 VLWs

for 90 days. The training started on 5th December-2012 and is in a continuing phase since then, at GVT-KVK. VLWs are being trained on various agricultural aspects like agronomy, plant breeding, plant protection, horticulture, animal science etc. From 5th-8th January-2013, VLWs have learnt on apiary, vermicomposting, hybrid rice seed production as well as basic computer course through audio-visuals.
