

Exposure visit to WADI for Farmers from IFFDC Chhindwara, Madhya Pradesh

An exposure visit for the farmers from Chhindwara was organized by GVT, Ratlam on request of IFFDC (Indian Farm Forestry Development Cooperative Ltd.) Chhindwara at the Regional office from 7th February to 8th February 2013. The two days training cum exposure visit programme was organised for the 34 member team from IFFDC, comprising 30 farmers (Male and Female) and 4 officials of IFFDC. The first day of the programme was dedicated to an exposure visit to the WADI programme villages at Bajana block and the second day was for a day long training session on different aspects of the WADI programme. During the training session, the farmers were introduced with basic as well as important aspects of WADI programme and their queries. During the programme the technical specialist involved in WADI programme was present along with the RPM, Ratlam to make the programme proceed on the scheduled module. Along with the technicalities related to WADI the farmers were also introduced to the importance of post WADI activities like formation of Producer cooperative and Producer Company and their relevance for Small and Marginal agrarians. During the training a presentation on importance of formation of village level institutions and their relevance for the success of the programme was also discussed. The meeting was a participatory one and the farmers too marked their participation through warm discussion on the related topics.
