

## GVT-Krishi Vigyan Kendra, Godda Conducts Trainings for Farmers of World Vision

**Sponsored Training:** Gramin Vikas Trust - Krishi Vigyan Kendra, Godda conducted 10 nos. of trainings for farmers of WORLD VISION, an voluntary organization working for the upliftment of rural poor in Godda district from 15<sup>th</sup> May, 2013 to 24<sup>th</sup> May, 2013. Dr. Ravi Shanker, Programme Coordinator; Dr. Surya Bhushan, SMS-Plant Protection; Sh. Raj Pal Singh, SMS-Agronomy of GVT-KVK, Godda; and Sh. Subodh, Assistant Director, World Vision – East and Sh. John Koshi, Programme Manager, World Vision, Godda inaugurated the training programme.

The programme consisted of one-day training for the farmers of different villages under World Vision, NGO. In every training approx. 25-30 participants took part. In total, 256 farmers and farm women participated (234 males 22 females). The main feature of the training was that all the participants were Scheduled Tribes (ST).

The training programme was regarding pre-awareness for Kharif Crops. The sessions included topics like System of Rice Intensification (SRI), scientific cultivation of crops and vegetable like paddy, maize, pigeon pea, tomato, cucurbits, lady finger, brinjal etc.
